The Club Marine Mandurah Boat Show is on this October, and is the perfect opportunity for boat buyers to grab themselves a bargain!

Show director Peter Woods said the boating industry has been changing over the past few years, and Boat Show is adapting to suit the current market.

The 2016 Club Marine Mandurah Boat Show will be held on 7^{th} – 9^{th} October at the Mandurah Offshore Fishing and Sailing Club.

New brokerage section on water

The Club Marine Mandurah Boat Show will introduce an exciting new feature in 2016 with the launch of the new on-water brokerage section.

Peter Woods said this new addition to the Show was a result of demand from buyers, and would mean more opportunity for buyers to find exactly what they were looking for.

"The Show will now feature new and pre-owned vessels on water, with the brokerage section designed to allow boat buyers to view quality pre-owned boats and buy at reduced prices," Peter said.

"Interest from exhibitors has been extremely high, and the Show is estimated to have more than a dozen pre-owned boats on display."

Peter said the new brokerage display was fully supported and endorsed by the Marine Broker's Institute of Western Australia.

Try before you buy with boat and jet-ski demos

The Club Marine Mandurah Boat Show has always been utilised by exhibitors as the ideal avenue to launch new products onto the WA market. However as an extra marketing tool, Show Director Peter Woods said some exhibitors are now offering boat trials to even further demonstrate their product.

"The benefit of attending a Boat Show is the opportunity for buyers to get up close and personal with the products; to get a good look at the product and ask questions to help make their purchasing decisions," Peter said.

"At the Club Marine Mandurah Boat Show, we are taking this one step further by offering buyers the opportunity to go out on the water on a range of boats, to really test them out."

"This is obviously a major benefit for boat buyers, to be able to see how the boat performs on water. And for exhibitors, it's something extra they can offer on top of their static displays," Peter said.

The Mercury Demonstration Zone is back with a record number of boats available to demo. Peter said visitors can try out the new Quintrex 610 Trident, Surtees 700 Gamefisher Hardtop, Stacer Crossfire 509, Reflex Chianti 585, Revival 640 Fisherman and more.

Peter said other manufacturers have gotten onboard with their own demo areas as well. Visitors can try out up to 20 boats in total, including the new Haines Hunter 625 Profish, 640 Bay Sport and more.

Watch us Build a Boat!

Western Angler will unveil its awesome new project boat at the Club Marine Mandurah Boat Show! Custom built locally in Albany by Rhys Jones and the team at the legendary Westerberg Marine, the 5.5m aluminium centre console is an offshore fisherman's dream, with casting deck, live bait tank, kill tank and 200l fuel tank.

It is powered by a 150hp four-stroke BF150 Honda motor, and comes on a custom-built Westerberg trailer. Garmin has provided the marine electronics and GME the radio equipment, while a MINN KOTA electric motor will be mounted on the bow and make a superb tool for offshore fishing. The Boat Catch will make launching and retrieving a breeze.

The hull and motor will be on display next to the Fishing Stage during the Mandurah Boat Show, and the boat will be fitted out fishing during the three days of the show, culminating in a spectacular wrap being added to finish the boat on the Sunday.

Show visitors will be welcome to look over the boat and watch the installations, as well as discuss the project with members of the WAngler team and sponsors.
